Learn about apartment tailgating and how to keep yourself and your home safe

What is tailgating?

Tailgating is when someone who is not a resident tries to enter an apartment building without using a key or the door buzzer.

Why does it happen?

- They may not be trying to cause harm
- They may be trying to visit a friend or family member

Sometimes a person tailgating may want to commit theft or harm.

Remember, people entering the apartment building need to use a key, the door buzzer, or be let in by the person they are visiting.

What can you do?

If someone threatening tries to follow you into the building:

- Do not speak to them
- Do not try to stop them
- Do not follow them
- Call your landlord to let them know

Your safety is important

- If you see someone trying to tailgate, use another entrance
- Call 9-1-1 if you feel in danger
